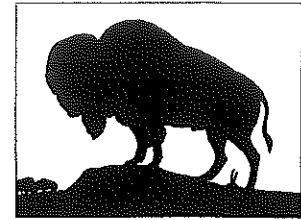


Packs for the Herd

Packs for the Herd offers North Sand Mountain students, in need, a bag of food items for the weekends and extended breaks, free of charge. Packs are distributed by their teacher on the last school day before the weekend or break. Typically, teachers or school administration identifies students who may benefit from the program. Students' names are kept confidential, and packs are given to students in a discreet manner. Research shows that proper nutrition is important for maximum academic performance.
